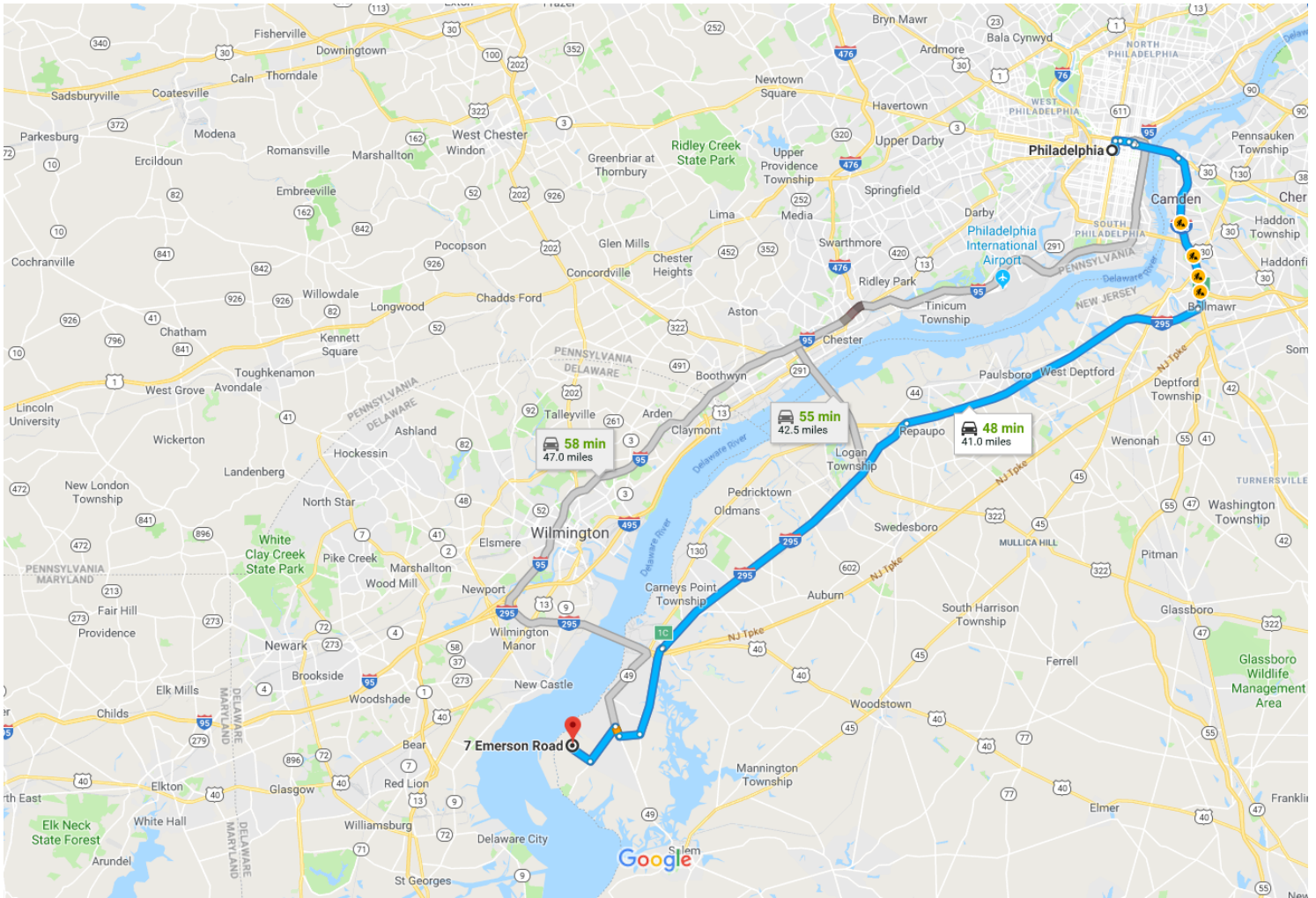

Get on I-676/US-30 E from S Penn Square and N Broad St

1. Head south on S 15th St toward S Penn Square
5 min (0.8 mi)
131 ft
2. Use the left lane to turn slightly left onto S Penn Square
315 ft
3. Keep left to stay on S Penn Square
0.2 mi
4. S Penn Square turns slightly left and becomes John F Kennedy Blvd
262 ft
5. Use the right 2 lanes to turn right onto N Broad St
0.3 mi
6. Turn right onto the Interstate 676 E/U.S. 30 E ramp to Interstate 95
0.2 mi

Follow I-676 and I-295 S to County Rd 551 S in Carneys Point Township. Take exit 1C from I-295 S

7. Merge onto I-676/US-30 E
32 min (33.1 mi)
0.3 mi

-  8. Use the middle lane to take the US-30 E/I-676 E exit toward Ben Franklin Bridge
- 0.2 mi
-  9. Use the left lane to merge onto US-30 E/N 6th St
- 361 ft
-  10. Use the left 3 lanes to turn left onto the Interstate 676 E/US 30 E/Ben Franklin Br ramp
- 0.1 mi
-  11. Continue onto I-676/US-30 E

-  12. Keep right to continue on I-676
- 3.8 mi
-  13. Merge onto I-76 E
- 1.8 mi
-  14. Use the left lane to take exit 1A for I-295 S toward Del Memorial Bridge

-  15. Continue onto I-295 S
- 12.0 mi
-  16. Continue straight to stay on I-295 S
- 12.5 mi
-  17. Take exit 1C for County Rd 551 S toward Salem
- 354 ft

Continue on County Rd 551 S. Take Fort Mott Rd to W Moreland Rd in Pennsville Township

- 12 min (7.1 mi)
-  18. Continue onto County Rd 551 S
- 3.4 mi
-  19. Turn right onto Mahoney Rd
- 0.8 mi
-  20. Turn right onto S Broadway
- 0.4 mi
-  21. Turn left onto Fort Mott Rd
- 1.6 mi
-  22. Turn right onto Lehigh Rd
- 0.8 mi
-  23. Turn right onto Clinton Dr
- 472 ft
-  24. Turn left onto W Moreland Rd
- 371 ft
