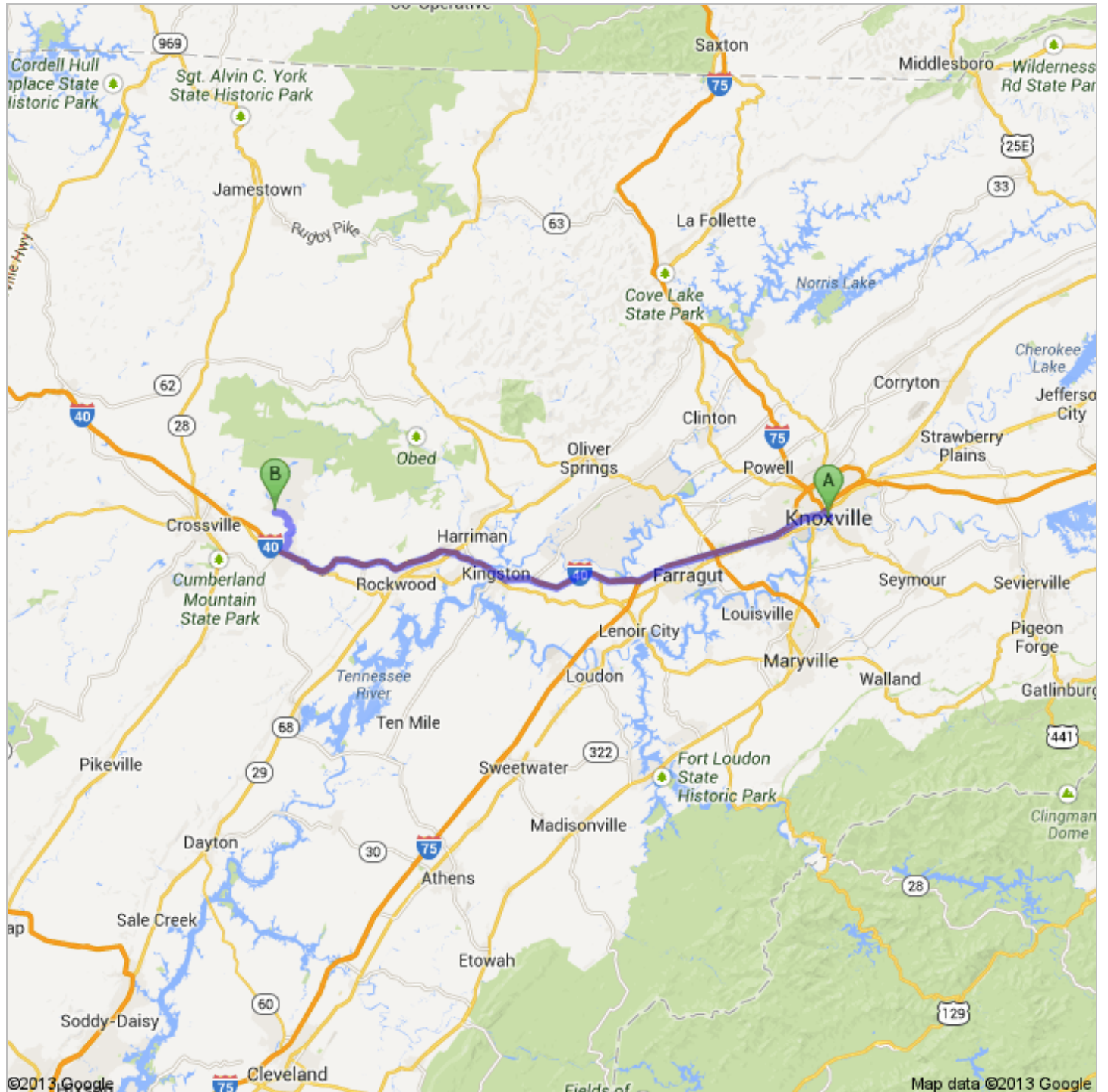

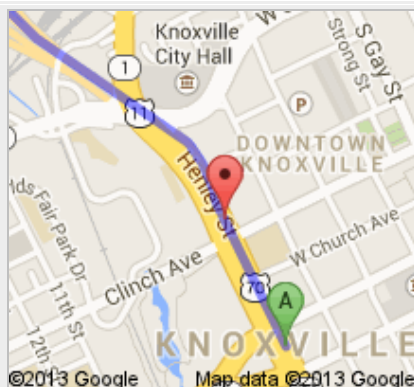
1. Head **northwest** on **Henley St** toward **Cumberland Ave**

total 0.2 mi



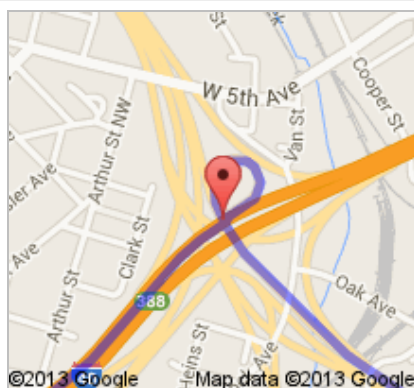
2. Take the ramp to **Nashville/Lexington**
