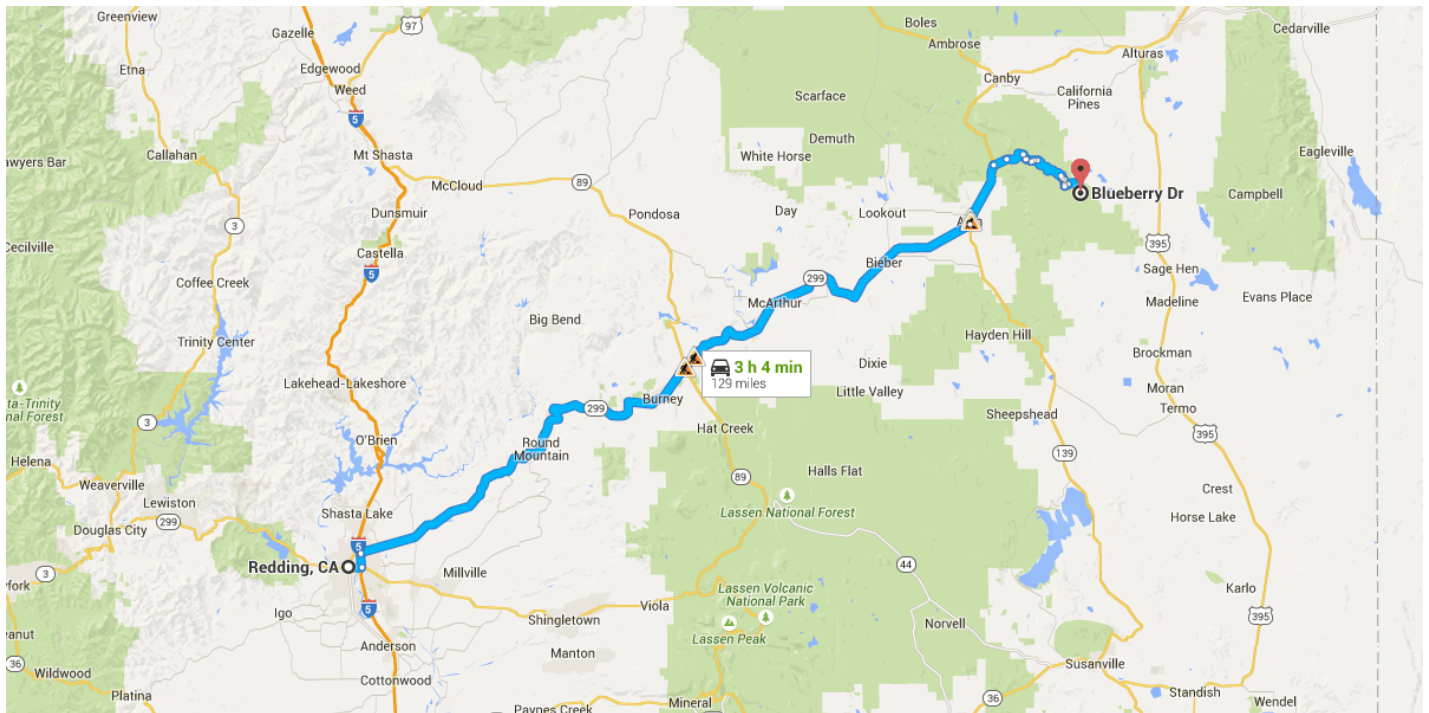


Directions from Redding, CA to Blueberry Dr

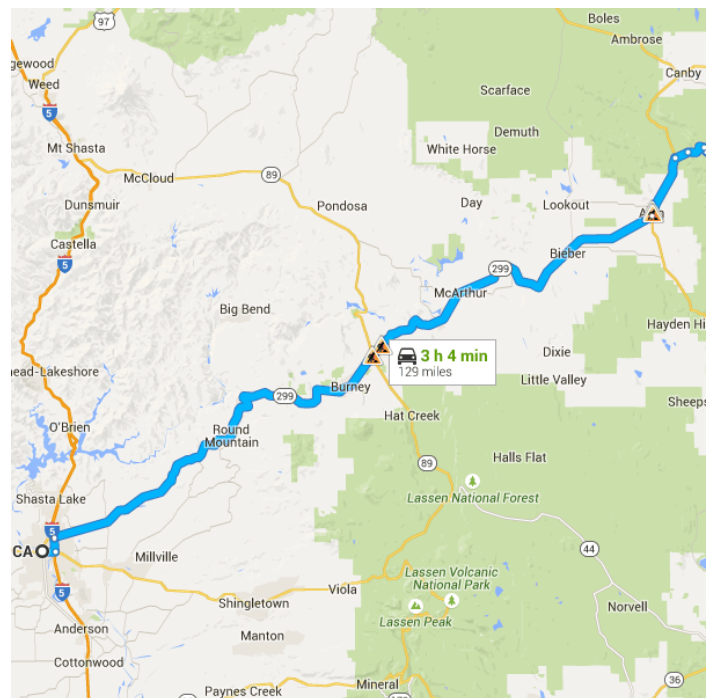


o Redding, CA

Follow CA-299 E to Co Rd 198 in Modoc County

112 mi / 2 h 3 min

1. Head **south** on **Market St** toward **Shasta St**
443 ft
2. **Market St** turns **left** and becomes **CA-44 E/Tehama St** (signs for I-5)
Continue to follow CA-44 E
1.7 mi
3. Slight **right** to merge onto **I-5 N** toward **Weed/Portland**
1.9 mi
4. Take exit **680** for **CA-299/Lake Blvd**
0.2 mi
5. Keep **right** at the fork, follow signs for **Burney/Alturas/California 299 E** and merge onto **CA-299 E/Lake Blvd E**
Continue to follow CA-299 E
100 mi



↶ 6. Slight left onto CA-139 N/CA-299 E
8.1 mi

Take Rush Creek Dr, California Pines Blvd
and Canyon Ln to Blueberry Dr

16.9 mi / 1 h 1 min

↷ 7. Turn right onto Co Rd 198
0.1 mi

↶ 8. Turn left onto Lower Rush Creek Rd/Rush
Creek Dr
Continue to follow Rush Creek Dr
1.7 mi

↑ 9. Rush Creek Dr turns slightly right and
becomes Rush Creek Dr
2.7 mi

↷ 10. Turn right
0.6 mi

↶ 11. Turn left toward Bighorn Rd
0.2 mi

↷ 12. Turn right onto Bighorn Rd
0.6 mi

↶ 13. Turn left onto Legend Rd
0.1 mi

↷ 14. Turn right onto Hoedown Rd
0.3 mi

↑ 15. Hoedown Rd turns right and becomes
Goulden Rd
0.5 mi

↷ 16. Turn right onto Topeka Rd
148 ft

↷ 17. Turn right onto California Pines Blvd
4.9 mi

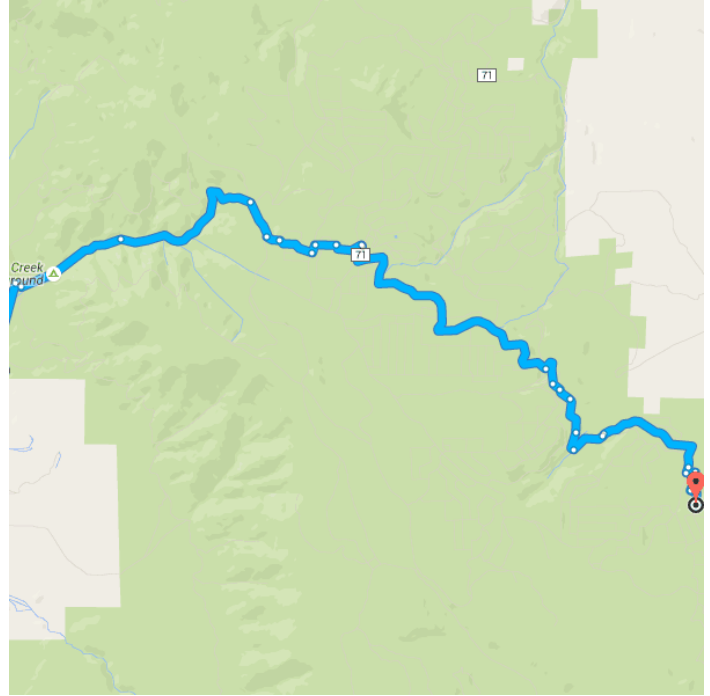
↑ 18. California Pines Blvd turns slightly left
and becomes Cal Pines Blvd
0.5 mi

↶ 19. Turn left toward Redwood Rd
0.1 mi

↑ 20. Continue onto Redwood Rd
0.2 mi

↑ 21. Continue straight onto Beaver Dr
0.6 mi

↑ 22. Continue straight onto Porcupine Ln
0.3 mi



- ↑ 23. Porcupine Ln turns slightly **left** and becomes **Pine Rd**
0.6 mi
- ↑ 24. Continue onto **Hilton Creek**
184 ft
- 25. Keep **right** to continue on **Canyon Ln**
1.9 mi
- ↑ 26. Continue onto **Canyon Rd**
436 ft
- ↶ 27. Turn **left** onto **Woodward Rd**
0.1 mi
- 28. Turn **right** onto **Timber Dr**
0.3 mi
- ↶ 29. Turn **left** onto **Blueberry Dr**
 Destination will be on the right
